In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation made by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Canton shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

CHAPMAN STREET (Southwesterly)

Beginning 100 feet southwest of Washington Street, 0.53 miles at 35 miles per hour thence southwesterly

thence Street; the total distance being 1.08 miles. ending at Neponset

CHAPMAN STREET (Northeasterly)

Beginning 100 feet northeast of Neponset Street, 0.53 miles at 30 miles per hour thence northeasterly

Street: the total distance being 1.08 miles.

SHERMAN STREET (Westerly)

Beginning 100 feet west of Pleasant Street,

1.19 miles at 30 miles per hour thence westerly

ending 290 feet east

of Beaumont Street.

SHERMAN STREET (Easterly)

Beginning 290 feet east of Beaumont Street,

1.21 miles at 30 miles per hour thence easterly

ending at Pleasant

Street.

WALPOLE STREET (Southwesterly) Beginning 100 feet southwest of Neponset Street, ending at the Sharon thence southwesterly 1.05 miles at 30 miles per hour line. WALPOLE STREET (Northeasterly) Beginning at the Sharon line, thence northeasterly 1.07 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Neponset Street. DEDHAM STREET (Northwesterly) Beginning 100 feet northwest of Washington Street, thence northwesterly 1.86 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at the Westwood line. DEDHAM STREET (Southeasterly) Beginning at the Westwood line, thence southeasterly 1.88 miles at 35 miles per hour ending at Washington Street. PLEASANT STREET (Southeasterly) Beginning 100 feet southeast of Washington Street, 1.50 miles at 35 miles per hour thence southeasterly 11 11 11 30 25 0.22 thence 11 11 35 11 11 ending at the Stoughton 0.70 line; the total distance being 2.42 miles. 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CANCELLED NO. 104 - 3 -Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper. The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14 of Chapter 90. The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing, after a public hearing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interests.
