SPECIAL REGULATION GOVERNING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON
TOWN WAY, IN THE TOWN OF WEBSTER

September 27, 1960.

SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 200

Highway Location: WEBSTER

Authority in Control: TOWN OF WEBSTER

Name of Highway: THOMPSON ROAD, Town Way

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation made by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Webster shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the beginning of Town Way,
 thence northerly 0.11 miles at 30 miles per hour
 thence 0.80 " " 35 " " "
 thence 0.09 " " 25 " " " ending 78 feet from
 the junction of East Main Street; the total distance being 1.00 miles.

SOUTHBOUND

Beginning 78 feet from the junction of East Main Street,
 thence southerly 0.09 miles at 25 miles per hour
 thence 0.80 " " 35 " " "
 thence 0.11 " " 30 " " " ending at the beginning
 of State highway; the total distance being 1.00 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing that this regulation is consistent with the public interest.

Standard signs must be erected at the beginning of each zone.
