SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 392

Highway Location: TOWN OF AMHERST  
Authority in Control: TOWN OF AMHERST  
Name of Highway: Triangle Street, Northeast Street,  
Bay Road.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted  
by the Board of Selectmen  
of the Town of Amherst

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

TRIANGLE STREET - WESTBOUND

Beginning at Main Street, thence westerly on Triangle Street

0.17 miles at 25 miles per hour  
thence 0.29 " " 30 " " "  
" 0.13 " " 25 " " "  
ending at North Pleasant Street. The total distance being 0.59 miles.

TRIANGLE STREET - EASTBOUND

Beginning at North Pleasant Street, thence easterly on Triangle Street

0.13 miles at 25 miles per hour  
thence 0.29 " " 30 " " "  
" 0.17 " " 25 " " "  
ending at Main Street. The total distance being 0.59 miles.

NORTHEAST STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet north of Main Street, thence northerly on North East Street

0.67 miles at 45 miles per hour  
thence 0.89 " " 40 " " "  
" 0.27 " " 25 " " " ending at Shutesbury  
Road. The total distance being 1.83 miles.

NORTHEAST STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Shutesbury Road, thence southerly on Northeast Street

	0.27 miles at 25 miles per hour	
thence	0.89 " " 40 " " "	
"	0.60 " " 45 " " "	
"	0.09 " " 25 " " "	ending at Main Street.

The total distance being 1.85 miles.

BAY ROAD - EASTBOUND

Beginning at the Hadley - Amherst line, thence easterly on Bay Road

	0.42 miles at 35 miles per hour	
thence	0.10 " " 30 " " "	ending at the beginning of State Highway, west of Route 116.

And beginning again at a point 160 feet east of Route 116, thence easterly on Bay Road

	0.74 miles at 40 miles per hour	
thence	2.37 " " 45 " " "	ending at a point 500 feet west of the Amherst - Belchertown line. The total distance being 3.63 miles.

BAYROAD - WESTBOUND

Beginning at the Belchertown - Amherst line, thence westerly in Amherst

thence	2.46 miles at 45 miles per hour	
"	0.67 " " 40 " " "	
"	0.10 " " 30 " " "	ending at the beginning of State Highway, east of Route 116.

And beginning again at the end of State Highway west of Route 116 thence westerly on Bay Road

	0.52 miles at 35 miles per hour	ending at the Amherst - Hadley line. The total distance being 3.75 miles.
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Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
