SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 394

Highway Location: TOWN OF DIGHTON
Authority in Control: TOWN OF DIGHTON
Name of Highway: Main Street, Center Street
Spring Street, Lincoln Avenue

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Dighton

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

Main Street - Eastbound

Beginning at Williams Street, thence easterly on Main Street
1.34 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.53 " " 35 " " "
0.53 " " 30 " " " ending at Water Street,
the total distance being 2.40 miles.

Main Street - Westbound

Beginning at Water Street, thence westerly on Main Street
0.53 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.53 " " 35 " " "
1.34 " " 45 " " " ending at Williams
Street, the total distance being 2.40 miles.

Center Street - Eastbound

Beginning at Williams Street thence easterly on Center Street
0.66 miles at 45 miles per hour
0.30 " " 35 " " "
1.06 " " 40 " " "
0.20 " " 30 " " "
0.33 " " 40 " " " ending at the
Berkley town line, the total distance being 2.55 miles.

Center Street - Westbound

Beginning at the Berkley - Dighton town line, thence westerly on Center Street

0.33 miles at 40 miles per hour

0.20 " " 30 " " "

1.06 " " 40 " " "

0.30 " " 35 " " "

0.66 " " 45 " " " ending at Williams

Street, the total distance being 2.55 miles.

Spring Street - Eastbound

Beginning at Forest Street, thence easterly on Spring Street

0.63 miles at 30 miles per hour

0.25 " " 25 " " " ending at the Taunton

town line, the total distance being 0.88 miles.

Spring Street - Westbound

Beginning at the Taunton town line, thence westerly on Spring Street

0.25 miles at 25 miles per hour

0.63 " " 30 " " " ending at Forest

Street, the total distance being 0.88 miles.

Lincoln Avenue - Northbound

Beginning 140 feet north of Tremont, thence northerly on Lincoln Avenue

0.67 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Spring

Street, the total distance being 0.67 miles.

Lincoln Avenue - Southbound

Beginning 230 feet South of Spring Street, thence southerly on Lincoln Avenue

0.65 miles at 30 miles per hour ending at Tremont

Street, the total distance being 0.65 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
