SPECIAL REGULATION GOVERNING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES
UPON CERTAIN TOWN WAYS IN THE TOWN OF LENOX - ROUTES 20 AND 7

August 21, 1951

SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 40

Highway Location: LENOX

Authority in Control: TOWN OF LENOX

Name of Highway: Main Street, Routes 20 and 7
Walker Street, Routes 20 and 7
Kemble Street, Route 7

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation made by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lenox shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC - ROUTES 20 and 7

Beginning at the end of State highway,
 thence southerly on Main Street 0.25 miles at 30 miles per hour
 thence 0.45 " " 25 " " " via Main Street
 and Walker Street to the beginning of State highway on Walker Street.

(Beginning again on Kemble Street.)

thence 0.08 miles at 25 miles per hour to the beginning
 of State highway on Kemble Street; the total distance being 0.78 miles.

NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC - ROUTES 20 and 7

Beginning at the end of State highway on Kemble Street,
 thence northerly 0.07 miles at 25 miles per hour to Walker Street.

Beginning again at the end of State highway on Walker Street,

thence 0.52 miles at 25 miles per hour via Walker Street
 and Main Street.
 thence 0.19 " " 30 " " " on Main Street
 to the beginning of State highway; the total distance being 0.78 miles.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing, after a public hearing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interests.
