SPECIAL REGULATION GOVERNING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STATE HIGHWAY,

ROUTE 19, IN THE TOWNS OF BRIMFIELD AND WALES

February 3, 1953

SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 61

CANCELLED

Highway Location: BRIMFIELD AND WALES

Authority in Control: COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

Name of Highway: BRIMFIELD, Wales Road and State Road Route 19
WALES, Main Street and Stafford Road Route 19

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby made by the Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, and shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

ROUTE 19 -- SOUTHBOUND

Beginning in Brimfield at the beginning of State highway,
 thence southerly 1.70 miles at 45 miles per hour to the Wales line.

Thence southerly in Wales,

	0.96 miles at 45 miles per hour	
thence	0.62 " " 40 " " "	
"	1.08 " " 35 " " "	
"	0.45 " " 40 " " "	
"	1.89 " " 45 " " "	
"	0.09 " " 40 " " "	ending at the Connecticut

State line, the total distance being 6.8 miles.

ROUTE 19 -- NORTHBOUND

Beginning in Wales at the Connecticut State line,
 thence northerly 0.09 miles at 40 miles per hour

thence	1.98 " " 45 " " "	
"	0.42 " " 40 " " "	
"	1.03 " " 35 " " "	
"	0.62 " " 40 " " "	
"	0.96 " " 45 " " "	to the Brimfield line.

CANCELLED

Thence northerly in Brimfield,

1.70 miles at 45 miles per hour to the end of State highway, the total distance being 6.8 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14 of Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing, after a public hearing, that this regulation is consistent with the public interests.
