# SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 9

In accordance with the provisions of Section 18 of Chaper 90 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.), as amended by Section 2 of Chapter 564 of the Acts of 1948, the following Special Speed Regulation is hereby made by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Concord. This regulation shall be effective immediately upon compliance with the applicable provisions of the above-referenced Section 2.

The following designated speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

### ROUTE 62-NORTHEASTBOUND TRAFFIC

# FAIRHAVEN ROAD\_SOUTHEASTROUND TRAFFIC

Beginning at Sudbury Road and thence southeasterly .20 miles at 25 miles per hour, ending at the northerly sideline of Route 2.

## FAIRHAVEN ROAD\_NORTHWESTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 250 feet northwesterly of Route 2, thence northwesterly .19 miles at 30 miles per hour, ending at Sudbury Road.

#### CAMBRIDGE TURNPIKE\_EASTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 250 feet easterly of Lexington Road and thence easterly 1.19 miles at 35 miles per hour, ending 350 feet westerly of Route 2.

## CAMBRIDGE TURNPIKE WESTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 300 feet westerly of Route 2 and thence westerly 1,24 miles at 35 miles per hour, ending 25 feet easterly of Lexington Road.

#### COMMONWEALTH AVENUE SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 200 feet southerly of Route 2 and thence southerly .51 miles at 30 miles per hour, and .32 miles at 20 miles per hour, ending at the junction with Main Street; the total distance being .83 miles.

#### COMMONWEALTH AVENUE\_NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning at a point 115 feet west of the N. Y. N. H. & H. R. R. tracks and thence northwesterly .29 miles at 20 miles per hour, and .53 miles at 30 miles per hour, ending at a point 100 feet south of Route 2; the total distance being .82 miles.

#### CHURCH STREET\_NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning at a point 60 feet north of Main Street, and thence northerly and easterly .13 miles at 20 miles per hour, ending at Commonwealth Avenue.

## CHURCH STREET SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning at Commonwealth Avenue and thence westerly and southerly .14 miles at 20 miles per hour, ending at Main Street.

## SUDBURY ROAD\_SOUTHWESTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 90 feet southwesterly of Main Street, and thence southwesterly .41 miles at 25 miles per hour .26 " " 30 " " " ending at Route 2; the total distance being .95 miles.

# SUDBURY ROAD\_NORTHEASTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 10 feet northeasterly of Potter Street, and thence 24 miles at 25 miles per hour 29 " " 30 " " " " ending at Main Street; the total distance being 96 miles.

# THOREAU STREET\_SOUTHEASTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 54 feet southeasterly of Main Street, and thence southeasterly .28 miles at 25 miles per hour .28 " " 30 " " " " to Walden Street; the total distance being 1.03 miles.

# THOREAU STREET\_NORTHWESTBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning at Walden Street, and
thence northwesterly .35 miles at 35 miles per hour
" 40 " " 30 " " " " ending at Main Street; the
total distance being 1.03 miles.

# EVERETT STREET SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 57 feet southerly of Walden Street and thence southerly .33 miles at 30 miles per hour to the northerly sideline of Thoreau Street.

# EVERETT STREET\_NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Beginning 51 feet northerly of Thoreau Street and thence northerly .33 miles at 30 miles per hour to the southerly sideline of Walden Street.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Section 14, of Chapter 90.

PENALTY Except as otherwise provided by statute, any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this regulation, or any amendment thereto, shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 20 of said Chapter 90.

The Department of Public Works and the Registrar of Motor Vehicles, acting jointly, do hereby certify in writing, after a public hearing, that this Regulation is consistent with public interests.
