SPECIAL SPEED REGULATION NO. 7297

Highway Location: BELMONT
Authority In Control: TOWN OF BELMONT
Name of Highway: LEXINGTON STREET

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section 18 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of Belmont

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

LEXINGTON STREET-NORTHBOUND

Beginning at a point 100 feet from Belmont Street
Thence northerly on Lexington Street
0.32 miles at 30 miles per hour
0.16 " " 25 " " " ending at Trapello
Road; the total distance being 0.48 miles.

LEXINGTON STREET SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at Trapello Road
Thence southerly on Lexington Street
0.16 miles at 25 miles per hour
0.35 " " 30 " " " ending at Belmont
Street; the total distance being 0.51 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed).
