Ignition interlocks	Any person permitted to drive with a restricted license requiring an ignition interlock device may be required to continue using the ignition interlock device for up to one year after completion of license suspension period
Vehicle impoundment	Impoundment and forfeiture of vehicle for 4 th (or felony) DWI/DUI.
Open Container laws:	May not be accessible to the driver. Passengers may possess an open container but may not imbibe.
