Ignition interlocks		The court shall require any persons who are convicted of DUI to equip any motor vehicle the person operates with an ignition interlock device during the period of statutory license suspension.
		Other than offenders that must drive to and from a farm, or operate a tractor while working on a farm, DUI offenders will be automatically issued an ignition interlock device. They may decline the device, but without it, the offender will face increased penalties.
		Exemptions: Employer
Vehicle impoundment		Impoundment, vehicle confiscation
Open Container laws		Open container must be in locked glove box, trunk, or otherwise inaccessible to driver and passengers, but does not apply to passengers of hired vehicles, motor homes, or house trailers.
